










Mesopotamia: Tigris and Euphrates Rivers



Canal irrigation system from modern Iraq, based on traditional models

- Getting water to land that could be cultivated
- Keeping water
 where it was needed
- Disposing of water when no longer needed
- Keeping unwanted water away





Implications of irrigation

- More structured forms of government
- Labour specialization
- Greater inequality
 - Better land = better productivity
 - Greater control over irrigation?





Epic of Gilgamesh (2700 B.C.E)








Nile River = 'Better' River

Less complex forms of irrigation










Ziggurat, Mesopotamia, 2100 B.C.E.
